





In 2021 youth grant recipients plan to teach kids about farm, animal, grain bin, noise, skin and electricity safety. Others will distribute bags of goodies to farmers during harvest with a message that it is good to stop and take a break.

I-CASH designates funds for community grants targeted at the prevention of farm-related injury and illness in young people and their families.

Each year, I-CASH distributes \$5000 among projects that involve youth in the planning and delivery of agricultural safety and wellness messages.

In the past 24 years, 192 grants have been awarded to 102 Iowa youth organizations totaling over \$150,000.





Many events were postponed or re-imagined in 2020. This group distributed 1st Aid Kits to elementary age children instead of a fair time event.
