INTRODUCTION

- Goals of the Great Plains Center for Agricultural Health (GPCAH) include:
- Improving awareness of health and safety risk faced by ag workers
- Disseminating impactful prevention tools to ag workers
- During the COVID-19 pandemic, interactions with farmers were restricted
- GPCAH developed a new podcast to stay connected with ag communities and to meet these goals

METHODS

- Reviewed existing ag podcasts
- Met with other podcast developers
- Developed core structure
- Incorporated feedback from regional advisors and community members

RESULTS

- 15-minute episodes
- Farmer-told stories
- Evidence-based recommendations
- Resources for implementation

EVALUATION (ONGOING)

- Tracking metrics on host platform
 - # downloads
 - *#* listeners
 - *#* subscribers
 - Listener locations
- Audience engagement
- Reviews
- Comments
- Willingness to share stories

The FarmSafe podcast creates a space to connect with farmers and their advocates to discuss agricultural safety and health topics while highlighting GPCAH research across the region.




Fig. 1 Results from surveys on potential podcast topics (n=37 responses)




Fig. 2 Listener locations in the US reported by Buzzsprout host platform Oct. 2021. Other locations include Germany, Canada, and Finland.
