Firearm Suicide on the Farm

Compared to other workers, farmers are more likely to die from suicide using a firearm.

From 2013 to 2019, the firearm suicide rate among farmers was more than **twice** the overall population's average rate.

Working in a high-stress job like farming and having **access to firearms at work** increases your risk of firearm suicide.

What can you do?

Safe storage may reduce risk of firearm suicide.

Safe storage includes storing firearms:

- 1. Locked
- 2. Unloaded
- 3. Separate from ammunition
